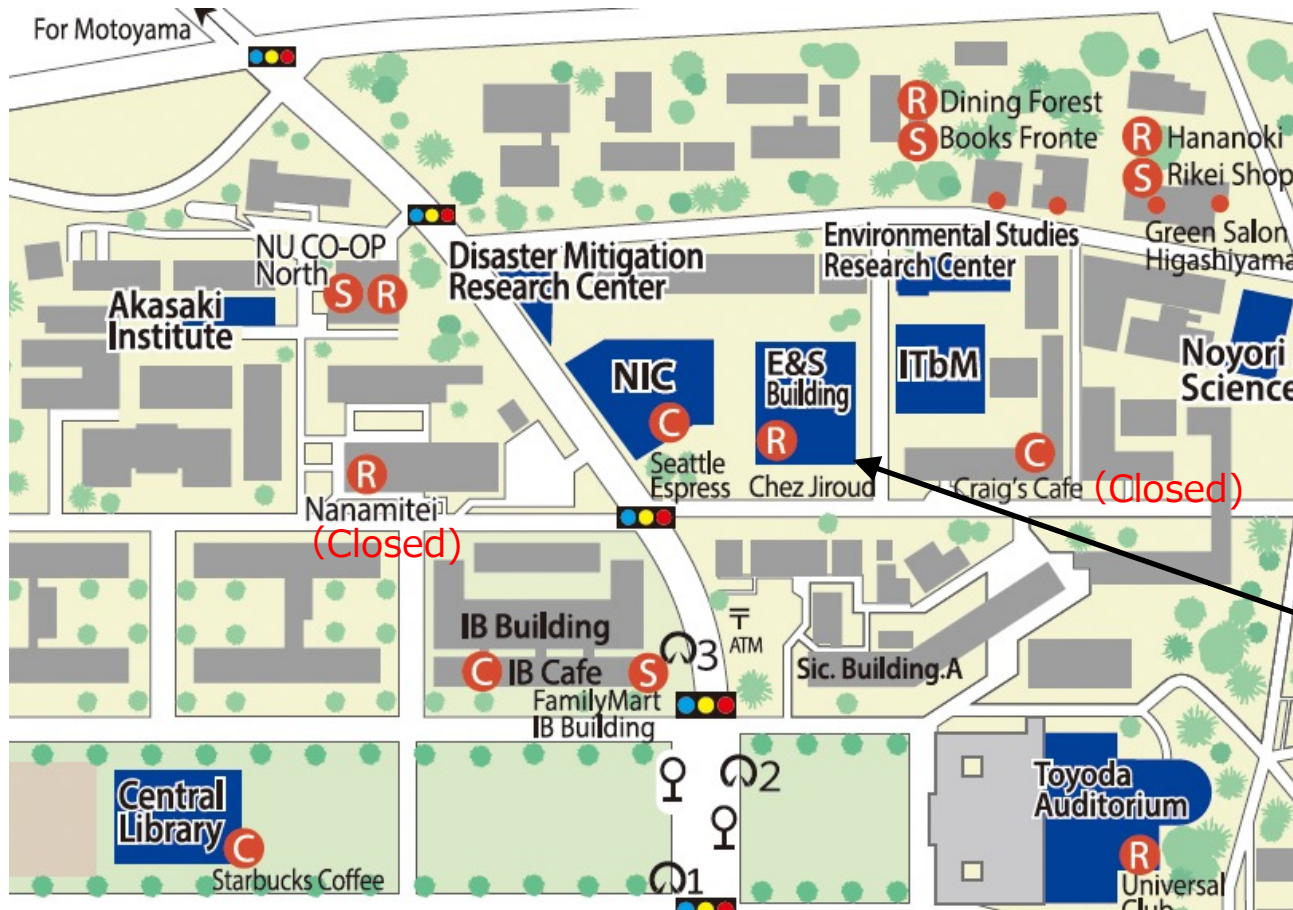
Machine-gun talk session will be held at the beginning of the poster session at the venue (ES635). In the session, the poster presenters are asked to talk about their presentations for 1 minute.
