










## The Los Angeles area/Pasadena/Caltech




- Los Angeles is both a county and a city

   of 137,000












## Conferences at Caltech

  - International Advisory Committee and Local Organizing Committees are being formed














Cahill is diagonally across California Blvd from the Lauritsen HEP building














### **Social Events**


- > Welcoming reception on campus on June 5 (Sunday afternoon)
